Welcome back – I am very excited about my opportunity to be principal of Bert Ambrose School and am looking forward to working with everyone. Staffing

We have some staff changes for this year:

Mrs. Forster is joining us from Robert Ogilvie and will be teaching Grade 2-3. Mrs. Lee is also joining us from Robert Ogilvie and will be teaching Grade 5. Mrs. Finkensiep will be doing prep coverage at our school. Mrs. Giesbrecht is joining us from Duncan Cran as an EA this year. I hope you will join me in making them feel welcome in our school.

Class lists

Staff met and created class lists yesterday. The classes were created considering academic and social factors as well as parent requests where they could be accommodated with the goal of creating a successful year for everyone. Future changes will only be considered for sound educational reasons and all requests must be submitted in writing.

Kindergarten

Our kindergarten classes will start September 9 with a gradual entry plan to learn the new routines as follows:

September 9-11 – Students attend 8:45 – 11:45 – learning routines and snack time/recess behaviours/expectations

September 12-13 – Students attend 8:45 – 1:00 pm – routines and lunch time behaviours/expectations

Kindergarten teachers will be contacting parents to discuss these schedules further.

Morning procedures

The first bell rings at 8:45 – this allows transition time into the classes. Classroom instruction begins at 8:55 and this early morning instruction is critical to set the tone for the day and start the day in style. Students who arrive after this time need to report to the office to check in. If your child will be absent or late please phone the school. Knowing that your child or children are away really helps with the "kid check", because each morning we will do a phone check for students who are absent and have not phoned in. If parents or guests are visiting the school, please check in at the office; for safety reasons we need to know who is in the building at all times. Please ensure that we have up to date contact information and emergency contact information for you and your family.

Arrivals and Departures – Please use the parking lot for dropping off and picking up your children. We have put out the pylons to create an entry and exit lane for this purpose. Please do not stop or park in front of the school or on the south side of 114 Avenue as this congestion creates an unsafe situation on the road. Staff parking is in front of the primary classes; please do NOT park in these spaces. Together we can prevent any accidents – thank you for your help with this.
